- Campground (open late spring–fall)
- Motorized boat launch
- Swimming beach
- Nature play area and splash pad
- 3+ miles of nature trails for hiking
- 1+ miles of cleared paved winter hiking trails
- Trail connection to Mill Towns State Trail and Cannon Valley Trail

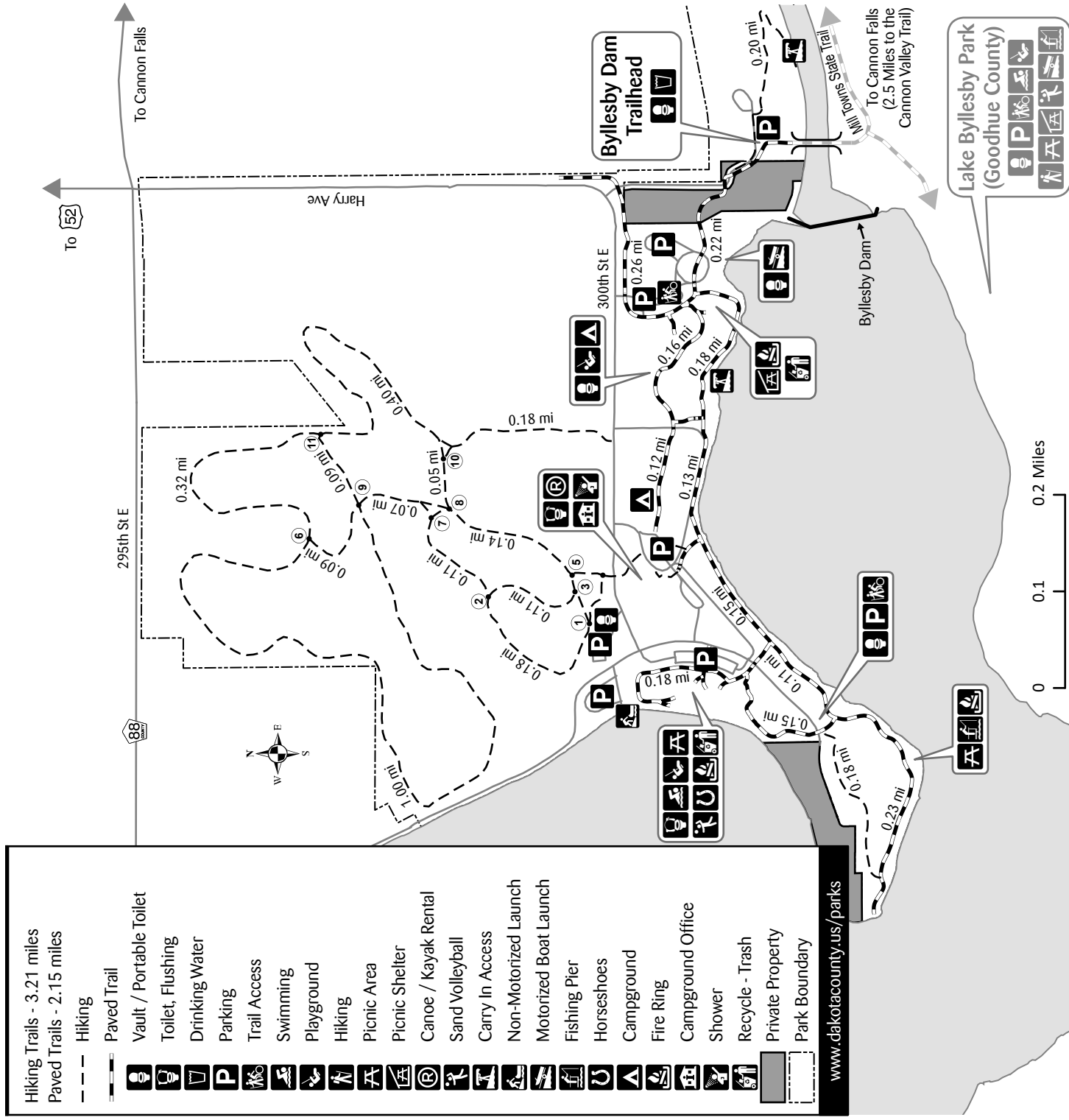
Spring-Summer-Fall Trail Map
