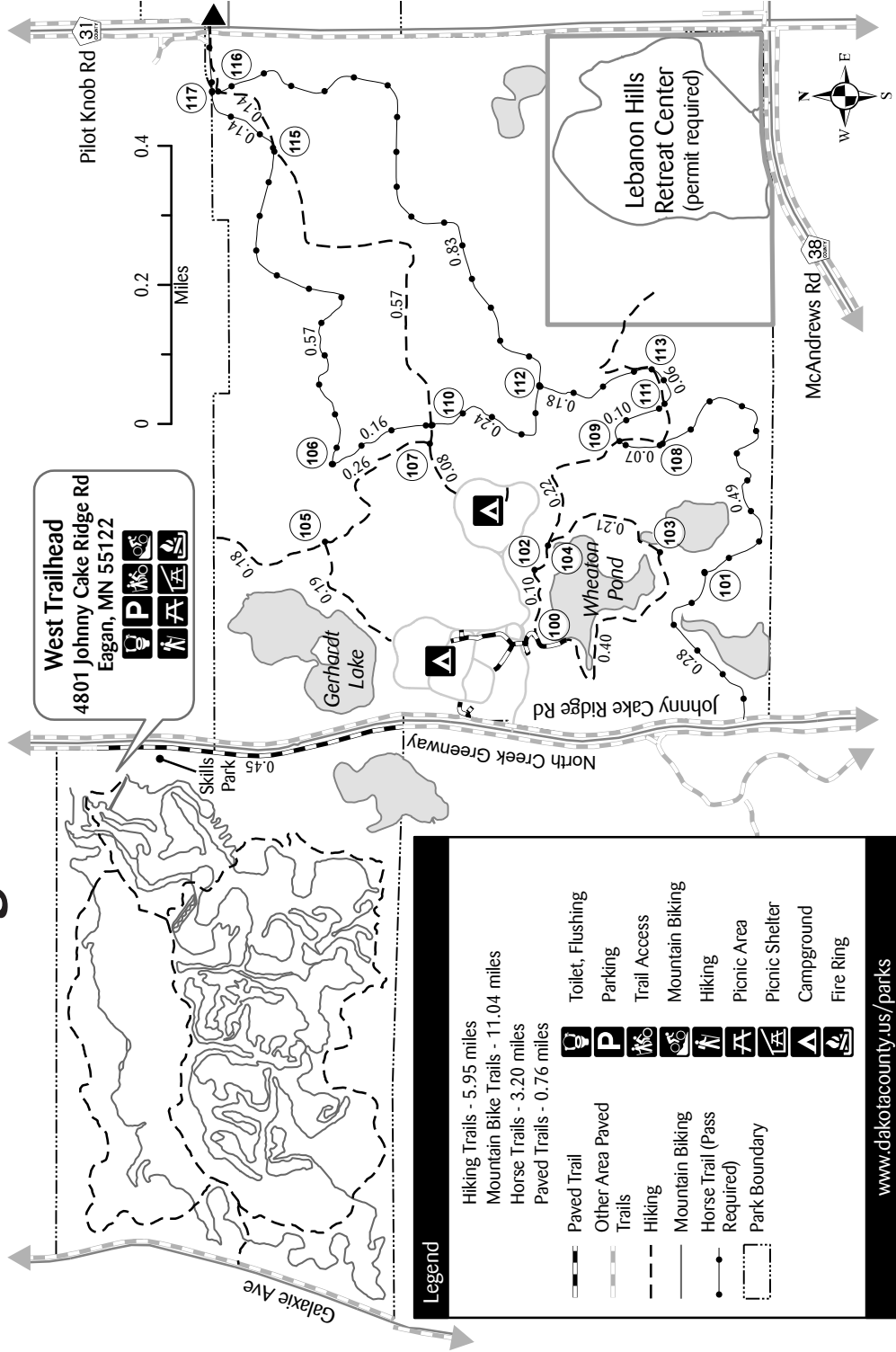


# Lebanon Hills Regional Park - West

## Equestrian Trail Pass

A Dakota County Parks equestrian trail pass is required for riders 18 and older. Passes are available online at [www.dakotacounty.us/parks](http://www.dakotacounty.us/parks) or in person at the Lebanon Hills Visitor Center. Daily passes are \$6 (plus tax) and season passes are \$35 (plus tax).

Lebanon Hills Regional Park is part of the Dakota County Park System.

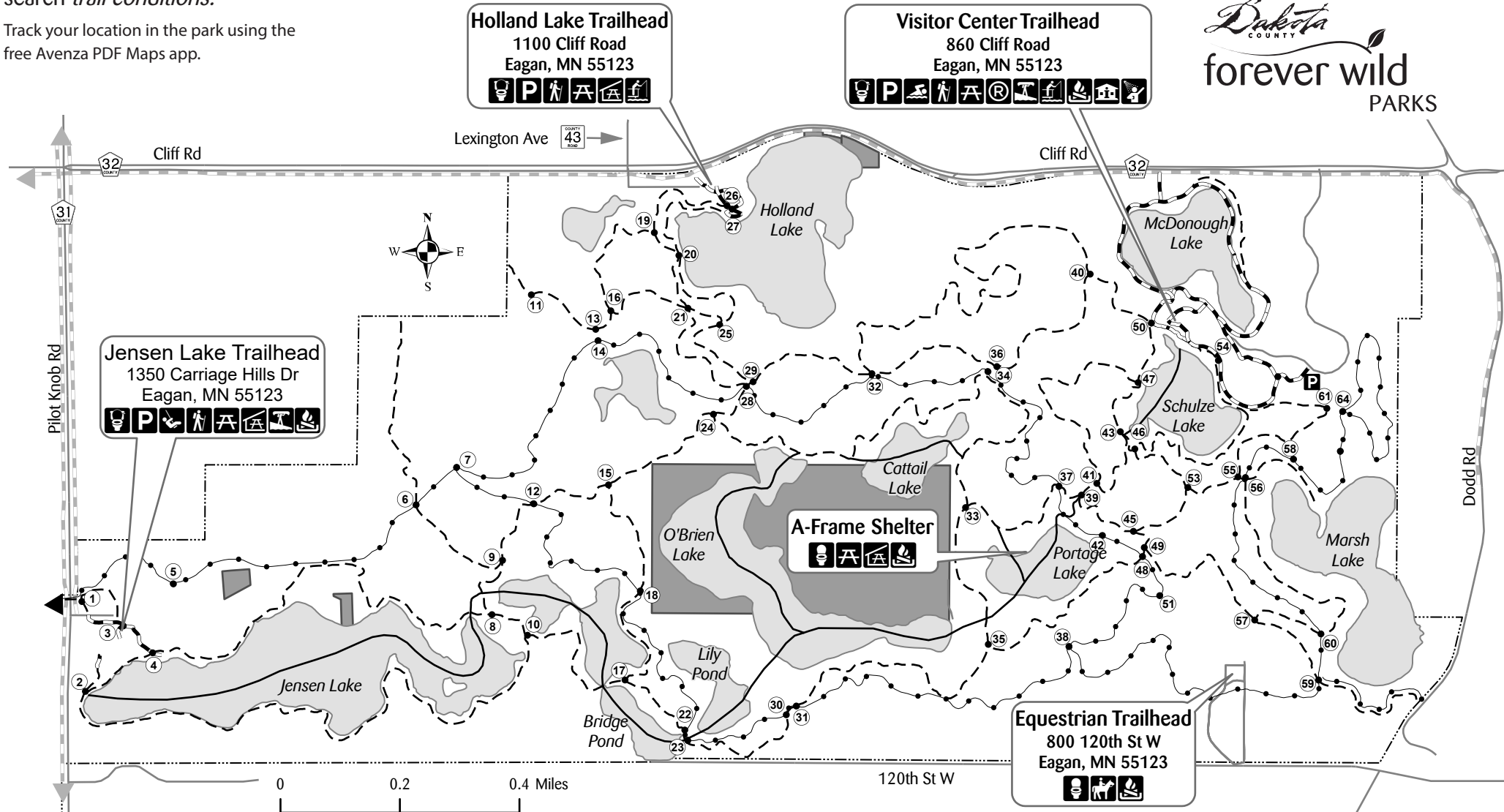
Admission and parking are free.

- Lebanon Hills Visitor Center (open year round)
- Campground (open late spring–fall)
- Canoe, kayak and paddleboard rental (open summer)
- 20 miles of nature trails for hiking
- Nearly 10 miles of equestrian trails
- 11 miles of single-track mountain bike trails and skills park
