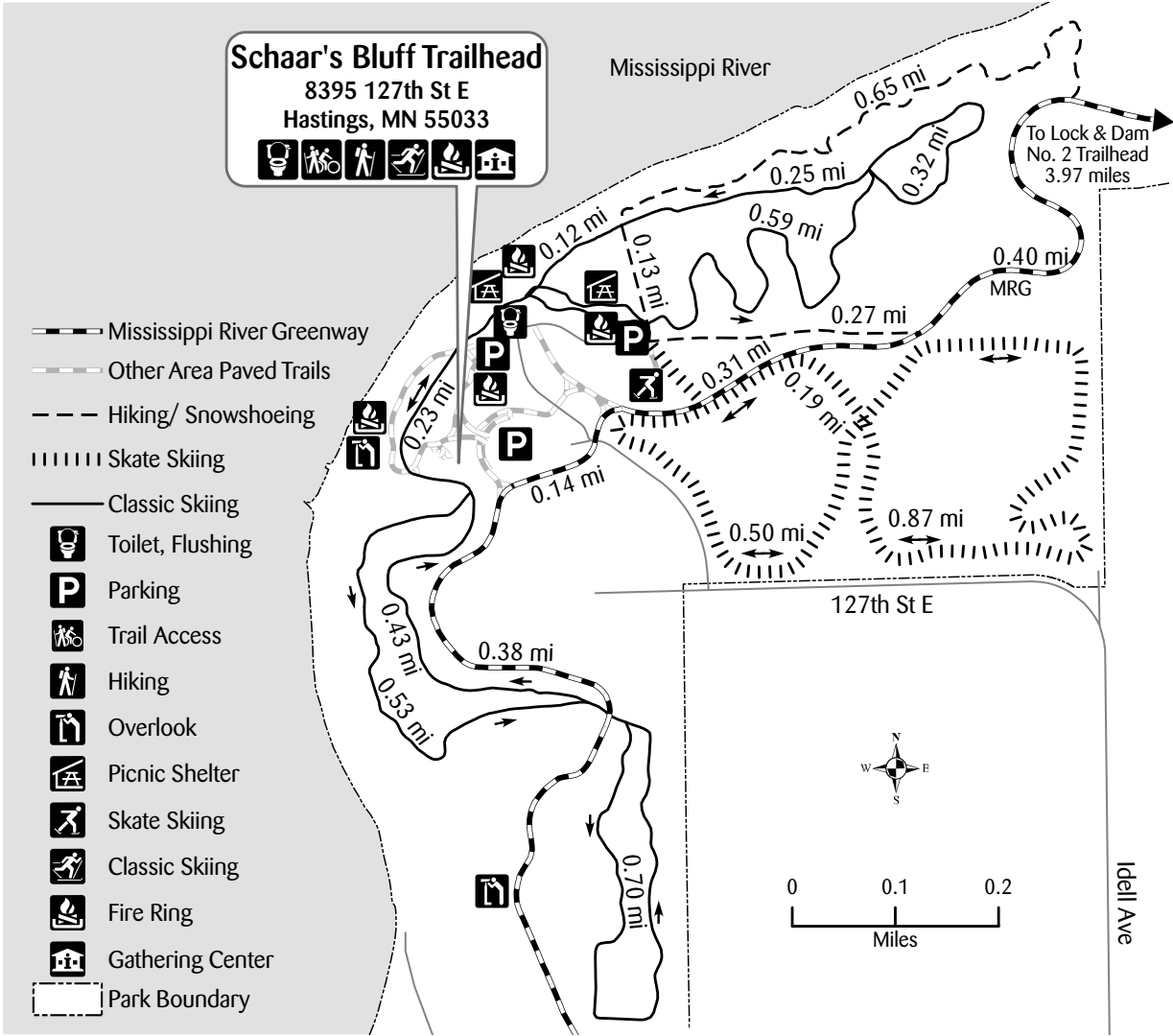

Cross-country ski pass

A Dakota County Parks ski pass is required for skiers age 18 and older. Passes are only available online at www.dakotacounty.us/parks, search *ski pass*, or in person at the Lebanon Hills Visitor Center. Daily passes are \$6 and season passes are \$25. There are no pay boxes at trailheads.

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Spring Lake Park Reserve

Welcome to Spring Lake Park Reserve. This park is a rest stop along the 3,000-mile Great River Road and offers miles of bluff-top trails with a bird's-eye view of the Mississippi River. Bison have been reintroduced to the park reserve in the Bison Prairie at Fahey Trailhead and along the Mississippi River Greenway. The bison herd rotates paddock locations and current location updates can be found on the Bison Prairie web page.

Spring Lake Park Reserve is part of Dakota County Parks.

Admission and parking are free.

- Schaar's Center Bluff Gathering Center (open year-round)
- Retreat Center with group camping (open year-round)
- 3 miles of nature trails for hiking/snowshoeing
- 3+ miles of groomed classic cross-country ski trails
